**Development Impact Analysis:**


1. **Land Use Compatibility**  
 Uses surrounding the proposed site are primarily single-family and vacant. The proposed "A-5" One-Family zoning **is compatible** at this location.
  
2. **Comprehensive Plan Consistency**  
 The 2014 Comprehensive Plan designates the subject property as single-family. The proposed "A-5" zoning is consistent with the following Comprehensive Plan policies.
  - Encourage development type and intensity appropriate to existing or planned street infrastructure. (pg. 38)
  - Encourage appropriate development and redevelopment within central city commercial districts and neighborhoods. (pg. 39)

Based on the conformance with the future land use map and policies stated above, the proposed zoning **is consistent** with the Comprehensive Plan.






### Area Zoning Map
