MINIMUM SPACING FOR CANOPY TREES = 50'-0" O.C.

MINIMUM SPACING FOR ORNAMENTAL TREES = 25'-0" O.C.

ALL TREES TO BE A MINIMUM 10'-0" OFF BACK OF CURB

ALL TREES WILL BE IRRIGATED WITH AN AUTOMATIC UNDERGROUND IRRIGATION SYSTEM WITH 2 BUBBLERS PER TREE AND DESIGNED PER TCEQ GUIDELINES

ALL TREES WILL HAVE A MULCH RING AT 3" MINIMUM DEPTH.
