As you may probably recall I am the “developer” of and General Partner of both FW Vista West, LP and FW Vista West II located facing Chapel Creek Blvd between Old Weatherford Rd and Westpoint Blvd. I am also the Declarant and President of the Vista West HOA of which FW Vista West, LP maintains the controlling interest in the HOA.

As you know from experience with our park as well as generally as a developer we favor the City's parks and park system.

Along with the Chapel Creek Neighborhood Association we were also supporters of Councilman Silcox many initiatives when he was alive and on the Council. Our Vista West developments are “neighbors” to the Chapel Creek neighborhood immediately to the south. Vista West assisted the CCNA in its early negotiations with the developer of their neighborhoods and related policy and development issues. We felt and feel the more parks in our greater neighborhood the better for the overall community.

Chuck Silcox Memorial Park**




