


Narrative Description

Sara Lovas' artwork for the Golden Triangle Library is an installation of multiple figures throughout the library. A bronze sculpture anchors the installation and features a stack of books being read by a small figure. The sculpture will be approximately 12.5" wide x 11.5" deep x 6.5" tall. From the stack of books emerges a shiny, silver-colored figure. Throughout the library are other shiny, cast aluminum figures on various adventures - exploring, climbing, jumping, running, crawling and more. These figures will be 13" - 14" tall with a bright frosted finish and will be placed inside and outside the library. Conceptually, this work addresses the joy, adventure, and new perspectives gained through reading and learning.











4. Balancing 5. Hanging On 6. Upside Down These figures will be placed in the wood ceiling trusses.








9. Investigating Figure
This figure will be crawling into a permanent shelving unit space.


