
Mayors & Councils:

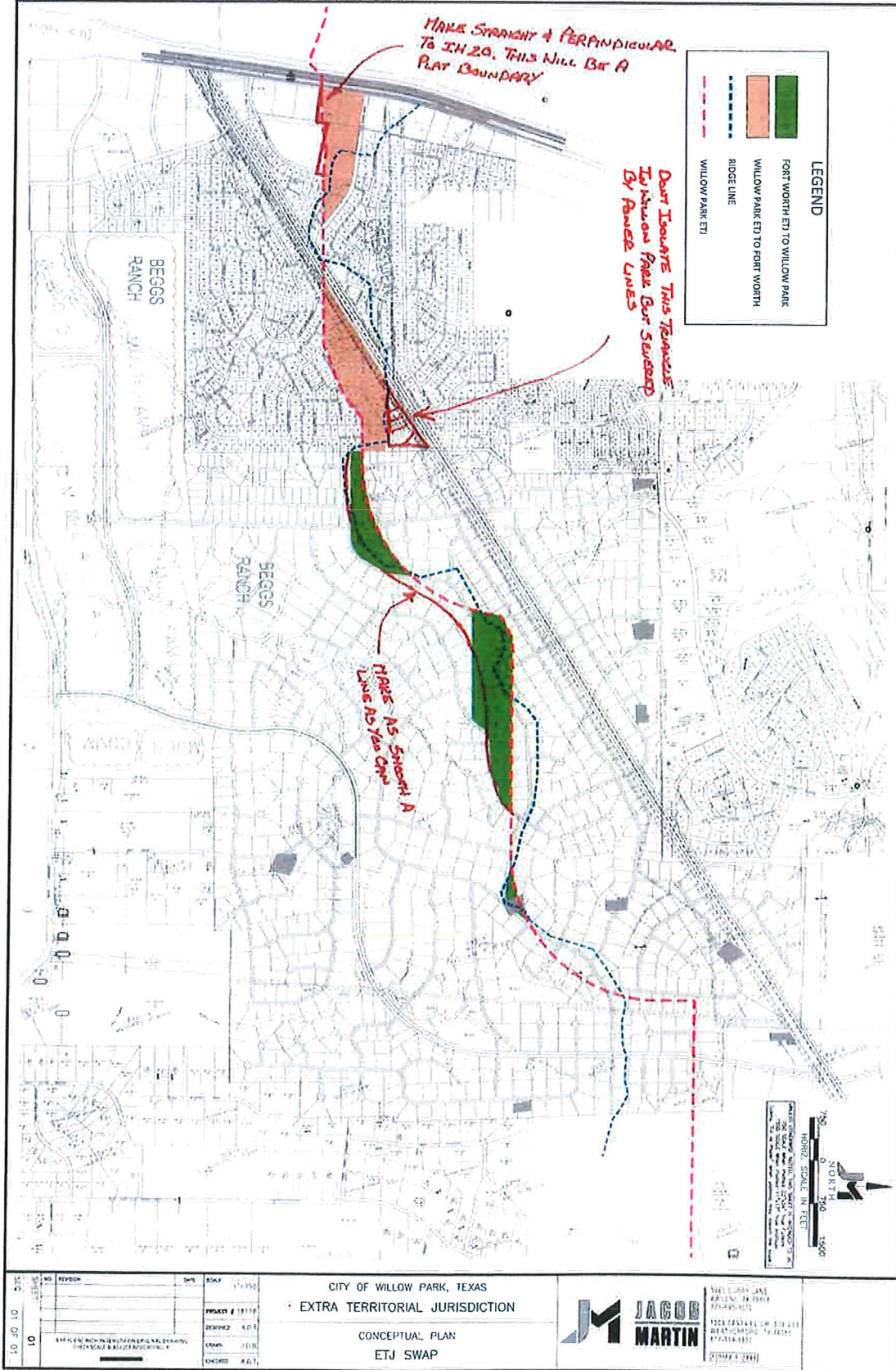

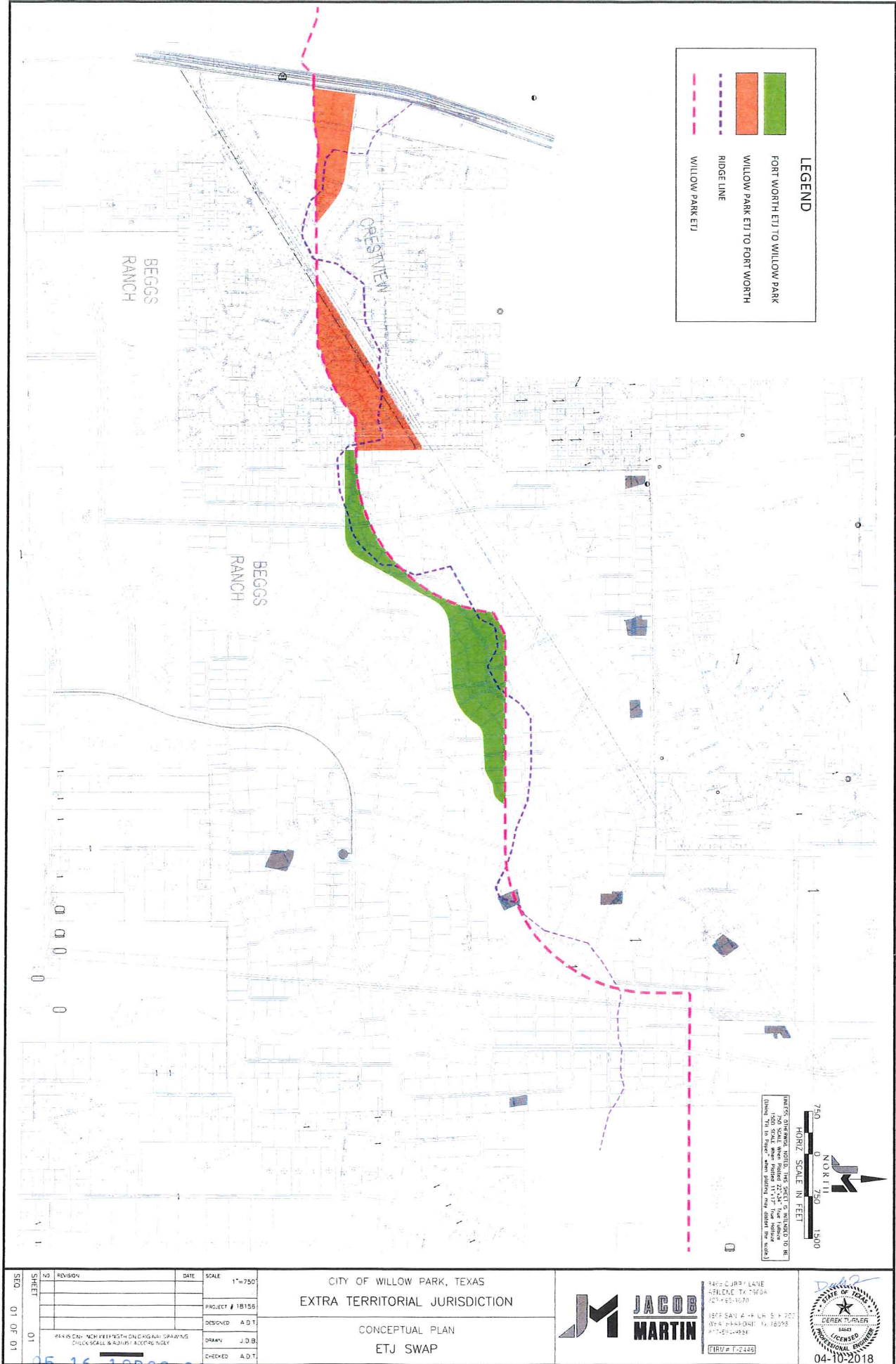
