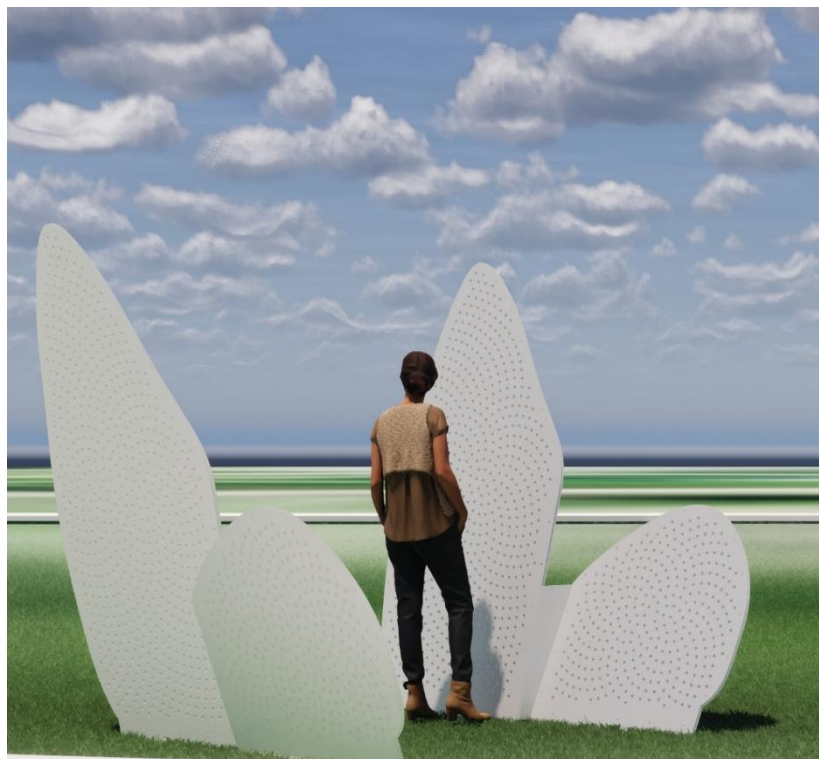

Northwest Community Park, 8575 Blue Mound Road

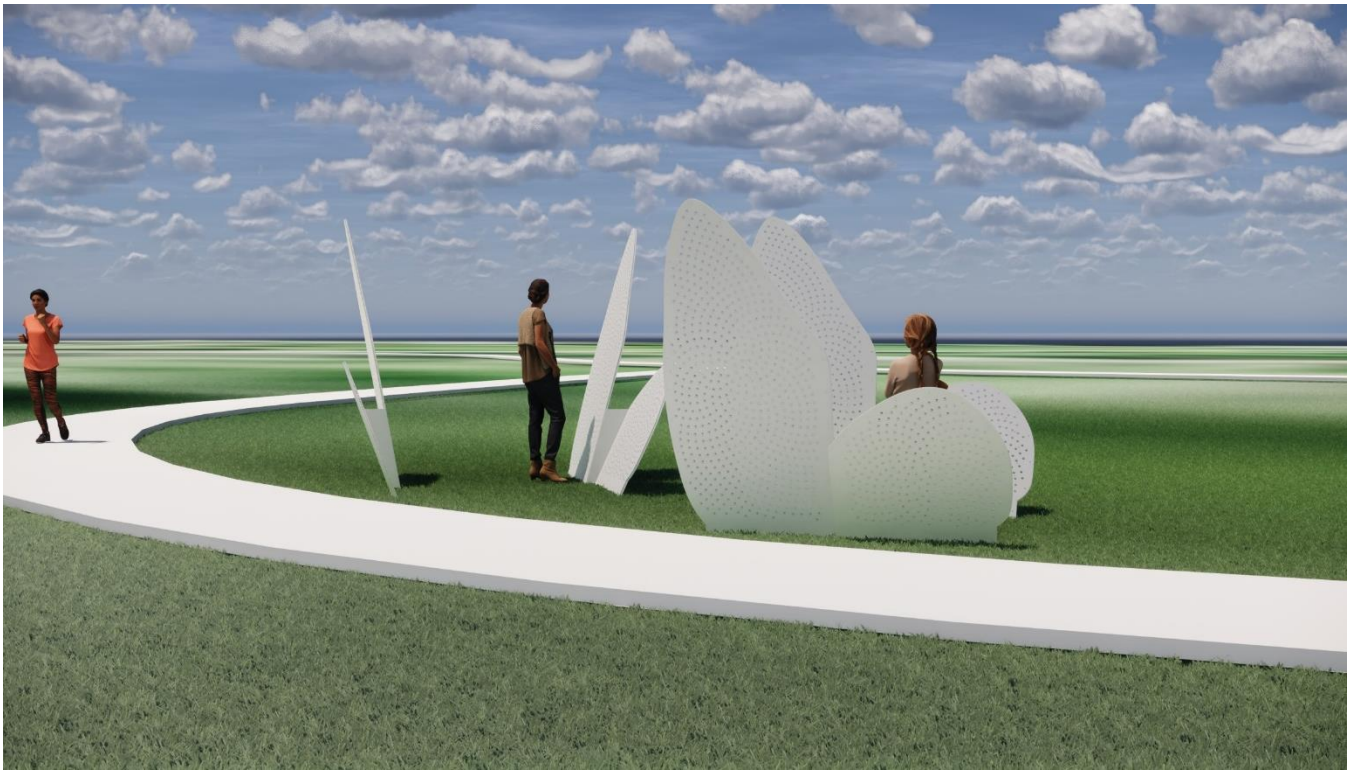


Narrative Description

Animalis Works, LLC. will create a series of three (3) stainless steel butterfly sculptures with embedded crystal prisms for Northwest Community Park. The numbered map above corresponds with the sculptures and locations listed below. Location 1 will include a small butterfly cluster with two sculptures of similar dimensions off a park pathway. Location 2 will serve as the site for the remaining, and largest, sculpture, which is directly divided by a park pathway. Conceptually, this work is inspired by the monarch butterfly migratory pattern that includes a stop at Northwest Community Park.



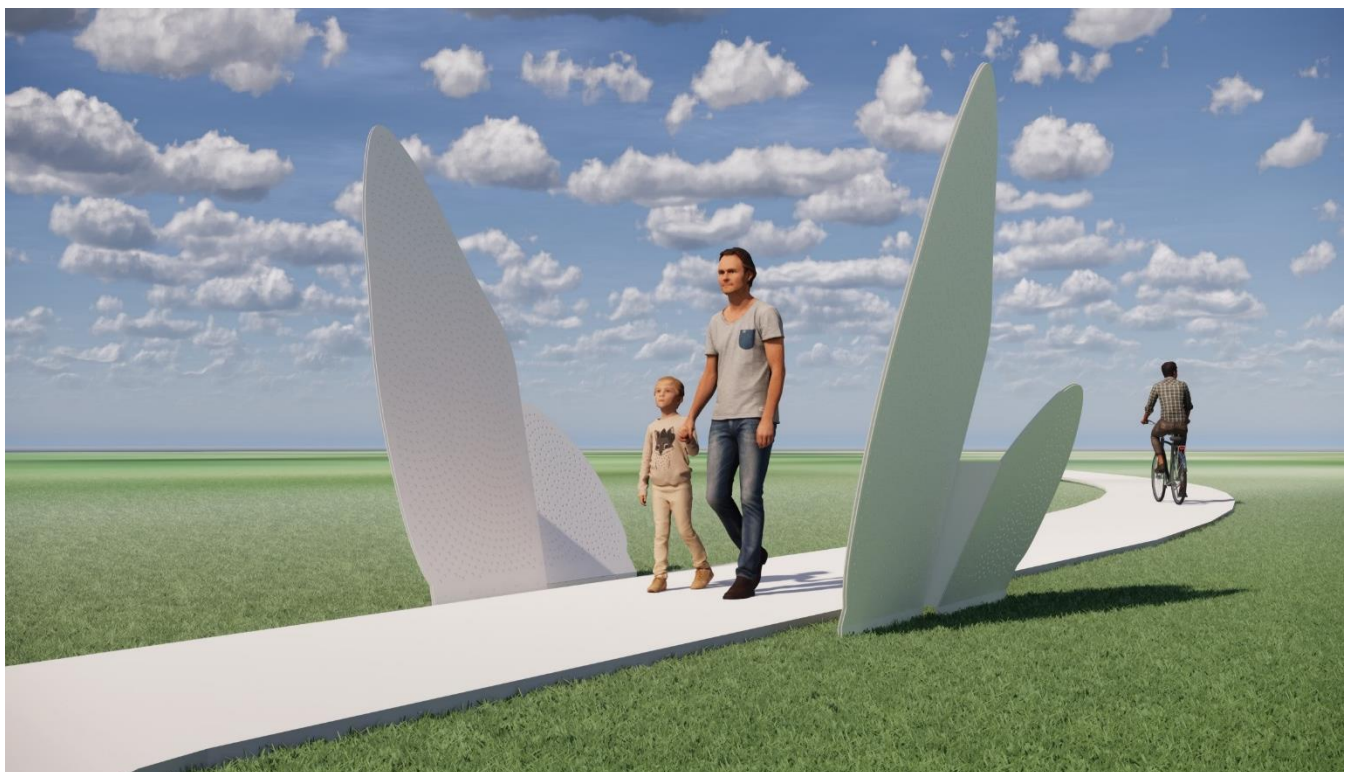
